

NEW TOWN REGULATIONS REGARDING DINGHIES AND OTHER WATERCRAFT ON TOWN PROPERTY

Waterways Regulations

sec. 1010(d) All dinghies, prams and tenders used to access moored vessels shall display a decal issued by the Harbormaster, on the port side inside of the transom.

sec. 1010(e) As a condition of each mooring permit, no one will be permitted to store their dinghy, pram or tender on town owned property after November 30th or before April 15th of each year, unless the dinghy, pram or tender is in active use by the owner/permit holder. Failure to remove the vessel from town property by those dates will result in being removed, fined or both. Any removal will be at the owner's expense.

Town Landing Regulations

4. All dinghies, prams, kayaks, sailboats and other forms of watercraft used as transportation on the water and stored along the shores of town-owned property shall either display a decal issued by the Harbormaster, or by other means, that clearly indicates ownership and contact information of the watercraft. All aforementioned watercraft shall not be permitted to be stored on town-owned property after November 30 or before April 15 of each year unless it is in active use by the owner.
