

**MARINE SANITATION DEVICE/POLLUTION CATEGORIES**

CODE	TYPE	DESCRIPTION
N	None	Vessel has <u>NO</u> toilet facilities of any kind
P	Portable	Vessel has a completely <u>self-contained</u> , not permanently installed, toilet which can be <u>removed</u> from the vessel for the disposal of waster (commonly referred to as a "porta-potti")
T1	Type I	Vessel is <u>less than or equal to 65'</u> in length, & has a <u>permanently</u> installed toilet facility which <u>treats</u> the waste prior to discharge overboard.
T2	Type II	Vessel is <u>greater than 65'</u> in length, & has a <u>permanently</u> installed toilet facility which <u>treats</u> the waste prior to discharge overboard.
T3	Type III	Vessel has a <u>permanently</u> installed toilet facility, & a waster holding system which does <u>not</u> allow any discharge overboard ("holding tank")
T3b		Vessel has a <u>permanently</u> installed toilet facility, & a 100% re-circulating system or incineration system which does <u>not</u> allow any discharge overboard.
T1/3		Vessel has a system <u>combining</u> a Type I & Type III system as described above. (Generally a valve to determine waste is directed overboard or into holding tank)
T2/3		Vessel has a system <u>combining</u> a Type II & Type III system as described above (Generally a valve to determine waste is directed overboard or into holding tank)
N/A	Not applicable	Applies <u>ONLY</u> to the following: Float, Swim Float, Rental Mooring, Mooring only, Transient Mooring.
