Composting is simply a combination of yard debris (grass clippings, fallen leaves, etc) and kitchen scraps (fruit, vegetables spoils, coffee grounds, tea bags, etc), separated from the waste stream and placed into an environment suitable for decomposition. Through composting, you can experience the benefits of this rich soil additive giving you healthier and greener lawns and gardens. By composting, you can remove more than 500 lbs. of organic matter from your household waste per year, diverting it from collection, the landfill, or incinerator. Enjoy the satisfaction of doing your part for the environment – get composting!
