Dear Property Owner:

In 2012, the Town of Chatham will celebrate its 300TH anniversary.

To commemorate this event, the Town of Chatham would like to honor the homes, built prior to 1900, which contribute to the historic character of our town. To accomplish this, the Chatham Historical Commission has approved a Tercentennial Historical House Marker which eligible homeowners may purchase and proudly display permanently on the exterior of their homes.

The Assessor's records indicate that your home is one of 428 buildings, in the Town, constructed prior to the year 1900, and, thus, eligible to display the House Marker. Some historic buildings, currently used for commercial or other purposes are eligible if the building was formerly used as a residence.

Enclosed please find information on the House Marker and ordering instructions. Whitehall Products, Inc. is the official distributor; having designed and fabricated the mold for mass production. The Company has provided the house markers for the Chatham Preservation Awards since 2004. Those markers, manufactured from the same materials, have proven to be maintenance-free and durable.

A House Marker has been mounted on the front of the Mayo House should you wish to view it prior to ordering. The Mayo House is located at 540 Main Street (next to Cape Cod Five Cents Saving Bank). Similar programs as this have been implemented on Nantucket and many other towns and the intent is not that the House Marker be readable from the street but that the existence of the house marker itself distinguishes your home as "special".

While the Chatham Historical Commission has approved the design and determined eligibility, the Town and Commission have no financial interests in this program. Thus, the responsibility for coordination for the ordering, payment and delivery rests solely between the homeowners and Company.

The members of the Chatham Historical Commission would like to congratulate you on having your property selected to display the Tercentennial House Marker. We would like to encourage you to order and mount it on your home as soon as possible. It is recommended that the House Marker be placed on the exterior, at eye level, to either side of the front door or door facing the street. It is anticipated that no sign permit will be required to display the House Marker regardless of where the building is located in town.

In the event that you have received this letter in error or that your home has been altered so that little of the historic construction exists, please disregard this letter.
