1. If you are mailing this *before* your 2014-2015 shellfish permit expires, **retain your 2014-2015 Shellfish Permit** and complete the “catch report” below. If you are mailing *after May 31<sup>st</sup>*, fill out catch report on the reverse side of your 2014-2015 permit and return with this form.
2. Enclose your check in the amount of **\$100** for each permit you are requesting, **payable to “Town of Chatham”**.
3. **A SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE IS REQUIRED.** *(If not enclosed, your permit(s) will be held at the Sticker Office for you to pick after May 15<sup>th</sup>.* Your new permit *will not be mailed back to you until after May 15<sup>th</sup>.*
4. Mail application, check, & self-addressed envelope to Chatham Sticker Office, 261 George Ryder Rd., Chatham, MA 02633.

**MUST BE FILLED OUT IF YOU HAD A PERMIT IN 2014**

Shellfish Permit holders shall estimate the previous year’s shellfish catch and file it with the Shellfish Constable. *(If you did not do any shellfishing, write a “0” on the catch report and return).* **A new Shellfish Permit will not be issued until this form has been completed** and submitted by the Permit Holder. The information will be held confidential. We use these figures to track which shellfish beds have been most heavily harvested and, therefore, need replenishing with seed. If you are not going to renew your permit, please fill out the catch report on the bottom of this page or on your current shellfish permit and return to us.
