

- **Paint and Painting Products** Please leave in the Paint Shed and/or feel free to take paint for your own use.
- **Mercury** All types of fluorescent lamps, mercury containing thermometers, thermostats, float switches, rechargeable batteries, and hearing aid batteries (button cell) should be left in the Mercury Shed.
- **Household Hazardous Products (HHP)** Regional HHP Collections are held the second Saturday of each month, May through October, 9:00-Noon at the Harwich Transfer Station, 209 Queen Anne Rd, Harwich.
- **Mixed Paper** All magazines, catalogs, cereal boxes, phone books, office paper, and newspapers can be placed in the mixed paper bin together.
- **Textiles** Towels, pillows, stuffed animals, shoes, hats, remnants, belts, purses, clothing, linens of all kinds — damaged items are OK. Put in designated bins.
- **Media** Books, CDs, DVDs, albums, cassette tapes, put in the *Book* bin.
- **Rigid Plastics** Barrels, toys, baskets, flower pots, crates, etc.
- **Kitchen/food Scraps** Drop off your food waste in the barrels at the recycling center for composting at Watts Family Farm in Sandwich (no meat/bones).
- **The Gift Shop** open from May to October, Friday-Monday 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

## Did you know that...

According to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts regulations the following materials are **prohibited** from disposal with household trash:

**glass**  
**metal**  
**plastics**  
**paper**  
**cardboard**  
**brush**  
**leaves**  
**batteries**  
**white goods**  
**tires**  
**electronics**  
**wood**  
**demolition debris**

<b>Newspapers / Junk Mail/Magazines/Paper</b>	Mixed Paper Bin	Twine, plastic bags, tissue paper, or carbon paper
<b>Phone Books</b>	Mixed Paper Bin	
<b>Corrugated Cardboard</b>	Flatten and place in container	Yellow, waxed or plastic coated, Remove staples and tape
<b>Returnable Cans and Plastic Bottles</b>	Scout Trailer (Support the local scout troops!)	Glass, non-deposit
<b>Returnable Glass Bottles</b>	Champ House Table	
<b>Cans, Tin, Aluminum, Steel</b>	Metal Bin	Food-contaminated foil or aluminum trays
<b>Glass</b> Clear, Green, Brown, and Black	Clean, remove rings and caps, place on tables	Windows, mirrors, plate glass, dishes, Pyrex, light bulbs
<b>*Plastics only #1-7</b> <b>*Bulk Plastic (chairs, barrels, etc)</b>	Clean, remove rings and caps/bulk items place in roll offs as directed	Unmarked plastics, bags, oil containers, Styrofoam
<b>Scrap Metal</b> Appliances (large/small) Bikes, Light Iron, etc. *Disposal fee applies	Drain fluids (gas/oil) Remove tires and doors	Automobiles, heating oil tanks
<b>Electrical Items and CRT's*</b> (televisions and computer monitors) *Disposal fee applies	Inquire at gate Fee collected per CRT item	
<b>Fluorescent Light Bulbs, Mercury Thermometers, Thermostats</b>	Leave at mercury shed	
<b>Batteries</b> Rechargeable, NiCad, Lithium Button cells	Leave at mercury shed	Alkaline batteries (dispose of in trash)
<b>Automotive</b> motor oils, antifreeze, oil filters, waste oil, tires* lead acid batteries *Disposal fee for tires	Place oil on table provided. Stack oil filters in building. Lead Acid Batteries inquire at gate	Contaminated liquids
<b>Paint</b> oil base, latex, thinners & stains	Original containers only oil & water-base paint, leave in paint shed (May - Nov.)	Damaged and unlabeled cans, hazardous material
<b>Yard Waste</b> Branches, Logs, and Trimmings	Empty bags on pile, cut logs into 4 foot lengths	Bags
<b>Compost Pile</b> Leaves, pine needles, grass, weeds	Empty bags on pile	Bags, trimmings and brush
<b>Food Waste</b>	Place in Watts Farm Barrell	
<b>Textiles / Clothing</b> ALL manner of clothing, linens, towels, shoes, hats, belts, remnants, purses, etc.	CLEAN and DRY Damaged or stained - ALL is acceptable! Bag and place in bin	Oil/blood contaminated
<b>Media</b> Books, CD's, DVD's, VHS, Cassettes, Vinyl	Leave in book bin	Encyclopedias, magazines
<b>Construction Materials</b> Lumber, bricks, drywall, etc.	Inquire at gate- fee applies	
<b>Ashes</b>	Inquire at gate	Hot coals
<b>Mattresses/ Upholstered Furniture</b>	Inquire at gate - fee applies	
<b>Gift Shop</b> Household items, small appliances, tools, books, toys, games, etc., as space allows	Leave at shop during hours of operation May - October Fri.-Mon. 10:00 am- 2:00 pm	Tires, paint, bedding, upholstered furniture, air conditioners, humidifiers, microwaves, broken items, cribs, playpens, car seats
