*(If you wish, you may also purchase non-resident permits for family members or friends who do not qualify for resident permits. We need copies of their drivers' licenses if they have not had prior shellfish permits in Chatham)*

(Note: The Sticker Office does not keep copies of driver licenses on file. They will be mailed back along with your permit.)

3. **A SELF-ADDRESSED, STAMPED ENVELOPE IS REQUIRED.** *(If not enclosed, your permit will be held at the Sticker Office for you to pick up after May 15<sup>th</sup>.)*

**MUST BE FILLED OUT IF YOU HAD A PERMIT IN 2013**

Shellfish Permit holders shall estimate the previous year's shellfish catch and file it with the Shellfish Constable. *(If you did not do any shellfishing, write "0" on the catch report and return.) A new Shellfish Permit will not be issued until this form has been completed* and submitted by the Permit Holder. The information will be held confidential. We use these figures to track which shellfish beds have been most heavily harvested and, therefore, need replenishing with seed. Even if you are not going to renew your permit, please fill out the catch report on the bottom of this page or on your current shellfish permit and return to us.
