SUSPECTS CHARGED IN RECENT CHATHAM LARCENIES

The Chatham Police Department has identified and charged two men who were responsible for a rash of recent residential and commercial break-ins and larcenies.

The crimes were first reported to Chatham Police from December 2011 through April 2012. The crimes had similar traits involving break-ins to private and commercial properties and thefts of power tools from garden sheds. The total property reported was worth several thousands of dollars.

The investigation, led by Chatham Police Detective Louis Malzone identified two suspects as responsible for the thefts.
