Vessels left on the premises longer than the approved duration may be fined and/or removed by the Harbormaster at the boat owner's expense.*

The permit applicant shall hold harmless and indemnify the Town of Chatham against any and all claims pertaining to the operations relevant to the Haul-Out process from the Town Landing. The Haul-Out permit holder agrees to abide by the Town of Chatham Waterways Regulations including, Sections 1027, 1028, 1029 & 1030 Commercial Haul-Out and Wash-downs.

**Wash down / pressure washing shall be done with the wash down trailer provided by the Town.**

***ALL TRASH TO BE TAKEN OFF PREMISES WITH YOU!***

1. You are responsible for coning off the approved area the night before.
2. Routine maintenance only. NO MAJOR REPAIRS ALLOWED.
3. Only Dust-Less Sanders are to be used. See section (q) 1, 2, & 3
4. Clean up of debris is required.
5. Tarps must be rigged to prevent any over-spray when pressure washing using only the Town supplied pressure washer.

(f) Vessel owners shall ensure that the vessel is covered with a full, in-force liability and pollution insurance policy of not less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) which names the Town of Chatham as an additional insured. The policy shall also hold harmless and indemnify the Town of Chatham against any and all claims and damages pertaining to injuries, damages to other boats or property, or pollution resulting from work on, or caused by, the vessel while the vessel is on Town property. **Proof of insurance shall be filed with the Harbormaster at the time of issuance of a permit.**
