FACT: Mercury is a toxic metal. When it is released into the air it can accumulate in people and wildlife.

It's the Law: The Massachusetts Mercury Management Act prohibits the disposal of products containing mercury in solid waste. (MassDEP 310 CMR 76.00)

What should Chathamites do:

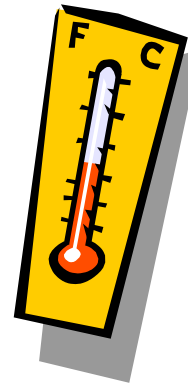
Drop off these items at the Chatham Health Department (261 George Ryder Rd.) and receive a FREE*

- Thermometers
- Thermostats

*While supplies last

Bring all other mercury products to the Chatham Transfer Station:

- **Florescent light bulbs**
- **Button cell batteries**
- **Flat panel display screens**
