CELL PHONE "ICE PROGRAM"

ICE stands for In Case of Emergency.

Safety professionals endorse a program in which you program your most important contact person(s) as "ICE Husband or ICE Alison or ICE 1, ICE 2" into your contacts phonebook in your cell phone.

The ICE program was first brought to the forefront following the London bus bombings.

Rescuers can use the cell phones of the injured to make emergency notifications and obtain quickly needed medical information.

It is an easy and effective way of getting information to an from emergency responders in a hurry.
