Chatham Municipal Airport Airport User Parking Policy

1. Airport User - Definition

Airport User means any person using or involved in activities at, in connection with, or in relation to the Airport, including without limitation, those who own and/or fly aircraft based at CQX, those who frequently fly to CQX and park their aircraft there on a transient basis, their passengers, staff of the airport, charter flight operators operating at the airport, their passengers and flight crew.

2. Facilities Available to Airport Users

The Chatham Airport has always allowed and encouraged airport users who frequent the airport for any type of business, pleasure or travel to park a vehicle at CQX as a service to the flying public. The intent is to make parking available to all users of the airport and to encourage public use of this valuable town resource. Vehicles parked or stored at an airport are an integral part of aviation airport usage and as such are a directly related aviation activity.

Parking Areas:

Outside Fence: The large gravel parking area outside the airport security fence is free for short term (less than 1 month) airport user parking. Short term use of this lot by non-airport users may be approved on request by the Airport Manager & Airport Commission in special cases.

Inside Fence: The area immediately to the left of main airport vehicle entry gate inside & along airport perimeter fence has a limited number (approx. 10) parking spots for a nominal fee basis to airport users. A parking permit

is issued to each vehicle in this area and is to be clearly visible. The permit will contain the location, license plate number and expiration date of the permit.

3. Restrictions and Limitations on Airport Users:

Airport users' vehicles parked inside and outside the fence must be registered and insured with valid license plates installed. Vehicle owners will be notified of expiration of either their vehicle registration or parking permit and given 30 days to remedy the discrepancy. Violators will be subject to tow and storage charges.

Vehicles parked inside the airport perimeter fence must remain clear of all runways and taxiways. Vehicles may be driven to an aircraft on the airport ramp only with the permission of the airport manager or his/her representative to load and unload baggage and passengers.

Hangar tenants may park their vehicle in their hangar while flying or in designated areas around the airport T-hangar complex.

4. Governing Body

The Airport Commission and the Airport Manager via the Airport Management agreement has discretion as to the public use of the airport user parking areas.
