Sewer Construction Update

Chatham – C.C. Construction, Inc. will be continuing work for the Phase 1D-2A: Route 137 – Morton Road Sewer Extension Project (1D-2A) and for the Queen Anne Pumping Station (QAPS) Upgrade as outlined below. N&M Excavating LLC will be continuing work for the Crowell Road Phase 2 & Chatham Fish Pier Infrastructure Project (Crowell Road Phase 2 & CFP) as outlined below.

Work for the week of June 12th – June 16th:

1D-2A:

- Sewer testing expected on Morton Road, Twine Field Drive, and Mill Hill Road. *Police detail(s) will be in place in the vicinity of the work to assist motorists.*
- Tentative – work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive).
- Drainage work expected to begin on Monday, 6/12 or Tuesday, 6/13 on Lime Hill Road at the southern end of the road. *Police detail(s) will be in place in the vicinity of the work to assist motorists.*

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- Paving is expected on Wednesday, 6/14 at the upper Fish Pier Parking Lot. *Upper lot will be closed.*
- Preparation for paving expected on Crowell Road between the intersections of Lake Street and Kendrick Harvest Way on Tuesday, 6/13 and Wednesday, 6/14. *One lane closure expected with alternating traffic.*

- Preparation for paving expected on Crowell Road between the intersections of Lake Street and Kendrick Harvest Way on Thursday, 6/15 and Friday, 6/16.
 - *Detour will be in place: Portion of Crowell Road will be closed between Stony Hill Road and Tip Cart Drive, and Lake Street will be closed. Traffic will be detoured via Tip Cart Drive to Barcliff Avenue to Old Harbor Road to Orleans Road to Stony Hill Road.*
 - *Once the Contractor is past Tip Cart Drive working towards Kendrick Harvest Way, detour will be in place: traffic will be detoured via Crowell Road to Main Street to Old Harbor Road to Orleans Road to Stony Hill Road.*

QAPS:

- No work planned.

Two Week Look Ahead (6/19 – 6/23):

1D-2A:

- Continue sewer testing on Morton Road, Twine Field Drive, and Mill Hill Road.
- Tentative – continue drainage work on Lime Hill Road at the southern end of the road.
- Tentative – work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive).

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- Continued road work expected on Crowell Road between the intersections of Lake Street and Kendrick Harvest Way. Paving is planned for Monday, 6/19 and Thursday, 6/22, with curb and sidewalk work to follow. *One lane closure expected with alternating traffic except for Monday, 6/19 and Thursday, 6/22 which will likely require the previous week's detours.*

QAPS:

- No work planned.

Three Week Look Ahead (6/26 – 6/30):

1D-2A:

- Tentative – work at Pump Station #3 (Meetinghouse Road) and Pump Station #4 (Twine Field Drive).

Crowell Road Phase 2 and CFP:

- Continued curb and sidewalk work on Crowell Road between the intersections of Lake Street and Kendrick Harvest Way. *One lane closure expected with alternating traffic.*

QAPS:

- No work planned.

Please note that this is a projected schedule and will be adjusted accordingly based on the Contractor's actual progress and the weather.

Roads will be passable at the end of each day. Police Details and Contractors will work with residents to ensure their needs for access are addressed.

Police Details and signage will be in-place to assist motorists in reaching their destination.

Normal work hours are 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday to Friday, weather permitting, unless otherwise noted.
